## RESOLUTION APPROVING A FARE INCREASE FOR THE NASSAU INTER-COUNTY EXPRESS BUS COMPANY

November 20, 2025

WHEREAS, Section 209(3)(a) of the Nassau County Charter (the "<u>Charter</u>") established the creation of the Nassau County Transit Committee (the "<u>Committee</u>") to review the services and operations proposed by the contractor that operates the Nassau Inter-County Express ("<u>NICE</u>") bus service; such services and operations including but not limited to fare increases; and

WHEREAS, Transdev is currently the contractor that manages, operates, and maintains the NICE bus service; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transit Authority (the "MTA") and NICE have agreed to allow cross-border connections free of charge for passengers travelling between Nassau County and Queens County pursuant to a transfer agreement if fares for their respective services remain at the same price; and

WHEREAS, if the MTA and NICE fares do not remain inline, NICE ridership would be required to pay an additional fare for cross-border connections; and

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2025, the MTA approved a fare increase for its bus service which increases bus fares from \$2.90 to \$3.00; such fare increase to become effective on January 4, 2026 (the "MTA Fares"); and

WHEREAS, the NICE bus service has proposed a fare increase from \$2.90 to \$3.00 (the "<u>NICE Bus Fare Increase</u>") to remain consistent with the MTA Fares so as to avoid NICE ridership paying an additional (double) fare for cross-border connections between Nassau County and Queens County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Nassau County Charter § 209(3)(a) (the "<u>Charter</u>"), the Committee shall conduct public hearings whenever there is a proposed fare increase, and every such public hearing shall be duly and publicly noticed in the official County newspaper as well as on the County website; and

WHEREAS, the Charter also requires that there shall be a minimum of two (2) public hearings, one (1) during the day and one (1) in the evening; and

WHEREAS, the Committee held duly noticed public hearings on November 13, 2025 during the day and evening; and

WHEREAS, the Committee held an additional duly noticed public hearing on November 20, 2025; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Committee hereby [approves/disapproves] the NICE Bus Fare Increase to become effective on January 4, 2026.
